5. Preventive Services (Medicare and Your 2021, pages 30-51)

These services are low cost or no cost. Check with your Primary Care Dr. about these for you. An ounce of prevention truly is worth a pound of cure.

6. Before you are admitted to a hospital or other overnight care institution, make sure you check to see your admittance is for treatment and procedures or only for observation. Observation only is not paid for by Medicare. You will have to pay out of your pocket.

7. If you have questions or concerns about your Medicare costs, healthcare coverage, and/or convenience, contact the Medicare Assistance Program of Oklahoma, which provides services year around for all Oklahomans receiving Medicare and sells nothing.
